WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

GROUPS AND SCHEDULES

Zoodoo Zoo offers two different Junior Keeper programs – one is designed for those aged 7-10 years old, the other is for those aged 11-15 years old.

Junior Joeys (aged 7-10)

This program will begin at 10AM. When you arrive at the Zoo, enter through the main front entrance, and follow the signs to the Keeper for a Day meeting point!

The program will end at around 3pm.

There will be 2 breaks throughout the day - 15 minutes for morning tea, and 30 minutes for lunch.

*IMPORTANT NOTE – this program requires a parent or guardian to be onsite for the entire duration of the program. Entry of one parent/guardian is included in the cost of the program. Parents/guardians are not permitted within back of house areas.

Junior Cubs (aged 11-15)

This program will begin at 9AM, when the Zoo opens. When you arrive at the Zoo, enter through the main front entrance, and follow the signs to the Keeper for a Day meeting point!

The program will end at around 3pm.

There will be 2 breaks throughout the day - 15 minutes for morning tea, and 30 minutes for lunch.

*IMPORTANT NOTE – Participants aged 12 years and under require a parent or guardian to be onsite for the entire duration of the program. Entry of one parent/guardian is included in the cost of the program. Parents/guardians are not permitted within back of house areas.

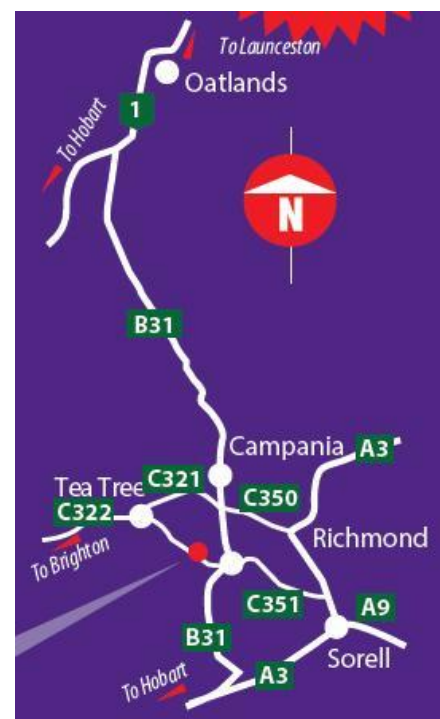

FOOD AND DRINK

Participants are required to bring a packed lunch for the day. We also request that they bring a re-fillable drink bottle.

Zoodoo has a Café and giftshop onsite and participants are more than welcome to bring money to purchase additional food, drinks, or souvenirs.

Note for Parents – our breaks will be in public areas of the Zoo, so parents/guardians are more than welcome to join us.

DRESS CODE

We ask that participants wear practical clothing and be prepared for all weather. Clothing must be neat and tidy but keep in mind that participants may get dirty working in the park. Sturdy practical footwear is a must. Please ensure that footwear is comfortable and fully enclosed – this is a Workplace Health and Safety regulation. No sandals, thongs or flip flops!

Participants will be provided with a Keeper for a Day hat and vest that they will be required to wear during the experience, to help identify them to our guests and other staff. Participants will also receive a name badge at the beginning of the day.

Participants are encouraged to bring sunscreen and sunglasses if they would like, as a lot of our day will be outdoors. Some sunscreen will be provided.

Jewellery is to be kept to a minimum. This is important for Workplace Health Safety.

REQUIREMENTS

Please be aware that this program includes guided tasks and therefore requires physical wellbeing and age-appropriate English communication skills. If you have any questions or issues with these requirements, please inquire further before booking the Keeper for a Day experience.
