Try an exciting day in the life of a Zookeeper with multiple animal interactions, preparation of animal diets, gathering animal data, creation of enrichment for the animals in Zoodoo's care, entering animal habitats to help our Zookeepers with their feed-outs, and of course, some of the dirty jobs like cleaning habitats!

The day in the life of a Zookeeper is always changing, making every experience unique! Keeper for a Day is the perfect mix of unique animal interactions, fun, exciting, and educational activities with some of the reality of being a Zookeeper!

Please note that while our Keeper for a Day participants often have in-habitat interactions with animals such as Marmosets, Meerkats, Macropods and Barnyard animals – alongside unique feeding experiences with Lions and Cassowaries – this experience is not encounters based. When you arrive at the Zoo, enter through the main front entrance, and follow the signs to the Keeper for a Day meeting point!</p> <p>The program will end at around 3pm.</p> <p>There will be 2 breaks throughout the day - 15 minutes for morning tea, and 30 minutes for lunch.</p> <p>*IMPORTANT NOTE ± Participants aged 16 years and under require a parent or guardian to be onsite for the entire duration of the program. Entry of one parent/guardian is included in the cost of the program. Parents/guardians are not permitted within back of house areas.</p>	<p>Keeper for a Day 16+ The program will begin at 9AM, when the Zoo opens. When you arrive at the Zoo, enter through the main front entrance, and follow the signs to the Keeper for a Day meeting point!</p> <p>There will be 2 breaks throughout the day - 15 minutes for morning tea, and 30 minutes for lunch.</p> <p>The program will end at around 4.20pm.</p>

Food

You will be provided with a voucher at the start of the day, valued at \$15 to spend in our Café and Gift Shop area. You are more than welcome to use this voucher to purchase your lunch, or you can bring your own!

Dress Code

Please wear practical clothing and be prepared for all weather. Clothing must be neat and tidy but keep in mind you may get dirty working in the park. Sturdy practical footwear is a must. Please ensure that footwear is comfortable and fully enclosed – this is a Workplace Health and Safety regulation. No sandals, thongs or flip flops!

You will be provided with a Keeper for a Day hat that you will be required to wear during the experience, to help identify you to our guests, and other staff. You will also receive a name badge at the beginning of the day.

Please bring sunscreen and sunglasses if you would like, as a lot of our day will be outdoors. Some sunscreen will be provided.

Jewellery is to be kept to a minimum. This is important for Workplace Health Safety.
